# Something to Ponder



Bessie Coleman, the first African-American woman in the world to earn a pilot's license, was born in 1892. Coleman decided that she wanted to learn to fly after hearing stories from pilots returning home after World War I, but no American flight schools would accept her due to her gender and race. She earned her international pilot license from the Fédération Aéronautique Internationale. After returning to the US, she specialized in stunt flying and earned the nickname "Queen Bess." She sought to inspire others to enter the world of aviation. She was inducted into the National Aviation Hall of Fame in 2006. When Mae Jemison became the first woman of color in space, she carried a photo of Bessie Coleman along with her.
